## Rules & Conditions

1. All riders, spectators, mounts, vehicles and equipment enter the grounds AT THEIR OWN RISK. A hazard risk assessment list will be on display at the PC Shed.
2. SWPC Rider Cups are eligible for financial members who have met the Rally Rule.
3. Entries accepted via email, or via post, on the Entry Form. Late fees of \$10 per mount will apply to all late entries without exception. Five entries per class or no 4<sup>th</sup> placing (where appropriate). The committee reserves the right to alter the programme and or entries at their discretion.
4. Ages are at the date of the show.
5. Protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 15 minutes of the completion of the event concerned and must be accompanied by a fee of \$100.00, to be returned if the objection is upheld.
6. The judge's decision will be final and it will be deemed unacceptable behaviour to approach and question a judge's decision.
7. Maiden events are open to horses and ponies that have not won a flat class at an A&P show, gymkhana, sport day or other equestrian event.
8. Maiden Rider Class is open to riders who have not won a rider class at an A&P show, gymkhana, sport day or other equestrian event.
9. Any person seen unnecessarily mistreating a horse or pony will be eliminated from the entire show, and if appropriate reported to the SPCA.
10. It is the rider's responsibility to enter the correct class and to advise the steward of any change in the jumping order. Failure to do so may result in elimination from the class. Events will not be delayed to facilitate riders on more than one mount if events are run at the same time.
11. Refunds (less 10% admin fee) will be given out if a VET or DR'S Certificate is produced within 7 days.
12. **NO DOGS ALLOWED AT ALL TIMES.** Offenders will be asked to leave. Please do not leave dogs in cars or trucks, instead leave them at home.
13. Use of the cross country is strictly prohibited (except in Eventer Class).
14. No dressage whips in flat classes
15. Safety helmets must be worn at all times. Eventers Class – all competitors must wear back protectors.
16. One rider per mount in the training ring.
17. The Committee reserves right to refuse entry without explanation.
18. All Showjumping will be run under ESNZ Showjumping Rules
19. No stallions allowed at this show. In-hand yearling colts MUST be appropriately restrained at all times, be wearing <S> Stallion Tags and handlers must be 18yrs or older.
20. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST be paid in full at the Secretaries office, prior to the commencement of judging
